KWH / YEAR

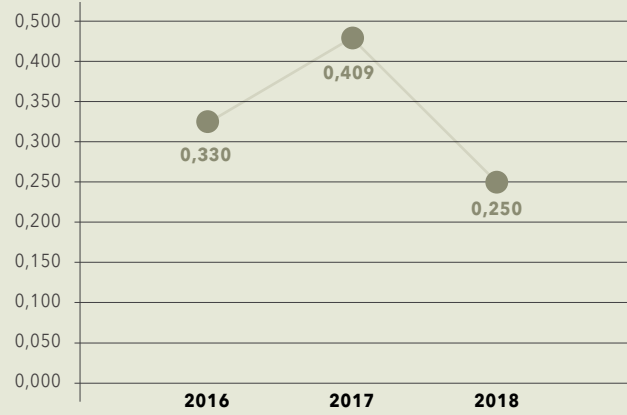

LITERS GAS / YEAR

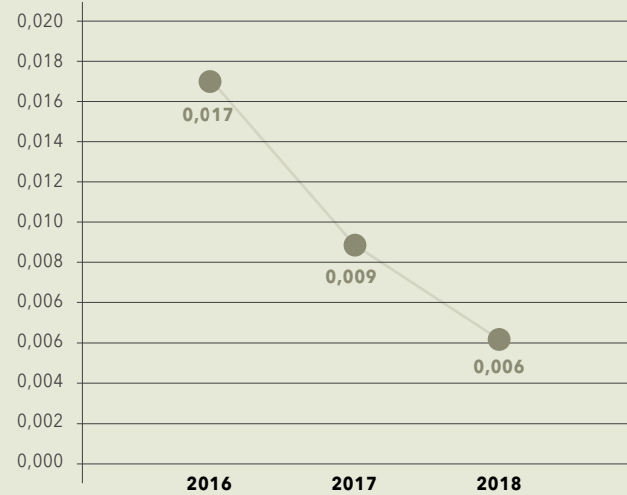

LITERS PETROLEUM / YEAR

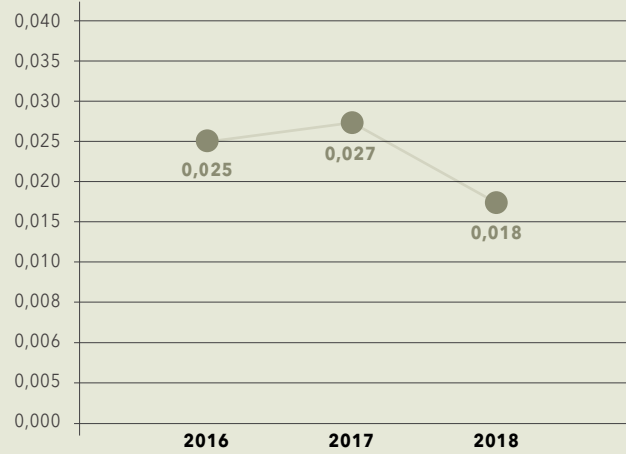

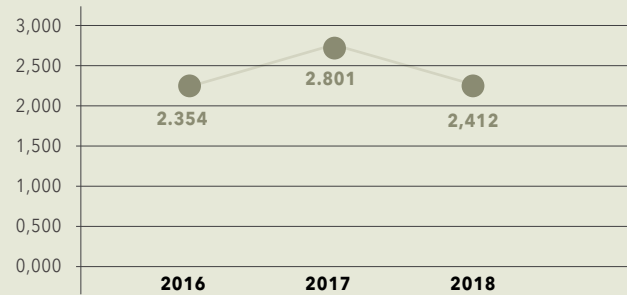

CERTIFICATIONS

Emiliana has international certifications that verify our commitment to sustainable production, with respect for our employees, the environment, and the community.

ORGANIC AND BIODYNAMIC

Emiliana began converting to organic production in 1998, and today 100% of the properties are organically managed. We have organic certifications in accordance with the standards of the United States, Canada (NOP), Brazil, Chile, Japan, South Korea, China, and Europe, which supports us internationally. Organic production has led us to produce our grapes and wines without the use of synthetic inputs (pesticides and fertilizers), sustainably manage natural resources, and integrate with the surrounding biodiversity. This has enabled us to care for the health of our workers, the environment, and our consumers.

In 2006, Emiliana was the first winery in Latin America to produce a wine with biodynamic certification. Since then, the use of biodynamic practices at our farms and cellars has been accredited, and today 100% of our properties are certified. Biodynamic agriculture employs the application of biodynamic preparations, considers farms to be autonomous productive systems (decreasing the use of external inputs), recognizes the importance of cosmic forces in agricultural management, and envisions the soil as a living being, where visible and invisible forces of nature interact to create healthy ecosystems.

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY AND FAIR TRADE

Fair Trade is a commercial relationship based on dialog, transparency, and respect and seeks equity in international trade. It contributes to sustainable development by offering better commercial conditions and safeguarding the rights of small producers and workers. It is an alternative form of commerce in which consumers opt to use their purchasing power to contribute to improving the living conditions of producers and workers by choosing products from companies that are socially, environmentally, and economically ethical.

Emiliana received its Fairtrade and Fair For Life certifications in 2011 and 2017, and we have been proud to sell Fair Trade wines since 2012. We also began Prime Use Projects in 2013. We currently have the Fair Trade Certification.



WINE OF CHILE SUSTAINABILITY CODE

Emiliana was a pioneer in the implementation of this certification in 2012. This standard was especially prepared for the Chilean wine sector as a means of supporting the implementation of sustainable practices at the national level as well as social and environmental responsibility at Emiliana.



WINE IN MODERATION

Wine in Moderation is a program with a strong presence in Europe that seeks moderate consumption of wine as para of a healthier lifestyle. The national program, led by Wines of Chile, establishes the principles and actions associated with responsible wine consumption so that its communications act in conjunction with current legislation.



VEGAN CERTIFICATION

Emiliana, the world's largest organic winery, has been certified to use the Vegan Society trademark, which accredits that the company's organic, biodynamic wines are produced without any animal-derived products.

The Vegan Society trademark is registered in Europe, the United States, Canada, Australia, and India and appears on more than 30,000 product labels around the globe. It is the international standard for authentically vegan products.
